

Organizations may submit multiple applications for funding. Individuals are not permitted to apply.



PCORI Funding Awards

Most of our primary research funding is awarded through PCORI Funding Announcements (PFAs), broad calls for projects aligned with our five National Priorities for Research and Research Agenda. We also issue 'targeted' announcements on specific high-priority topics, special one-time funding opportunities, and earlier funded a series of Pilot Projects to study methods for engaging stakeholders in research. In addition, we have launched a series of Engagement Awards, including our first Pipeline to Proposal awards; these are not research awards but are designed to better integrate patients and other stakeholders into the research process.

All proposed projects, including requested budgets and project periods, are approved subject to a programmatic and budget review by PCORI staff and negotiation of a formal award contract.

•LOI are longer, required and sometimes used as a screen

•Submission interface for letters and proposals take longer than NIH

•Cost and cost effectiveness aims are not allowed

•Right now you can submit application as many times as you want for their standard calls

•Look carefully at website for materials and for upcoming webinars

•PCORI takes the Patient and Stakeholder Engagement seriously (e.g., PCORI Patient and Family Engagement Rubric)
