COMPLETE A VISIT IN PERSON OR BY MAIL, EMAIL OR PHONE:

In this envelope, you will find a growth and development questionnaire for the LEGACY parent to complete and a growth and development questionnaire for the daughter as well, if she is 10 years of age or older. We would appreciate it if you could both complete these questionnaires and mail them back to us in the enclosed pre-addressed and pre-stamped envelope. As always, please complete these questionnaires independently. If you'd rather complete your questionnaires via phone or email, please let us know.

If you would like to come into our clinic and complete OS (the light test) along with your questionnaires, please call or email us to schedule an appointment—we'd love to see you! We will have LEGACY appointments every week on Thursdays and Fridays from 4-7pm, and one Saturday a month. TRACK YOUR PERIOD ON YOUR PHONE OR TABLET:

LEGACY girls who have started menstruating are eligible to participate in a pilot study that uses an app called CLUE to help track menstrual periods. We are very excited about this pilot, which has already been featured in New York Times magazine! Thank you to those who are already participating.
