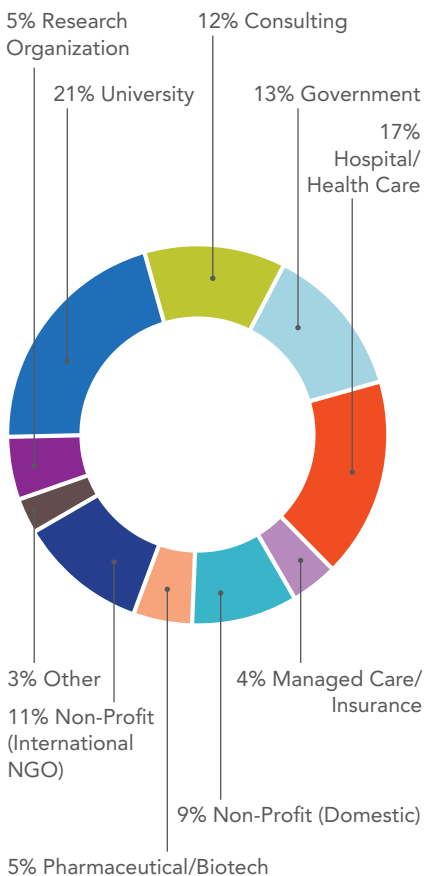
New York City Location and Global Reach

- We offer limited travel funding and practicum stipends for internships

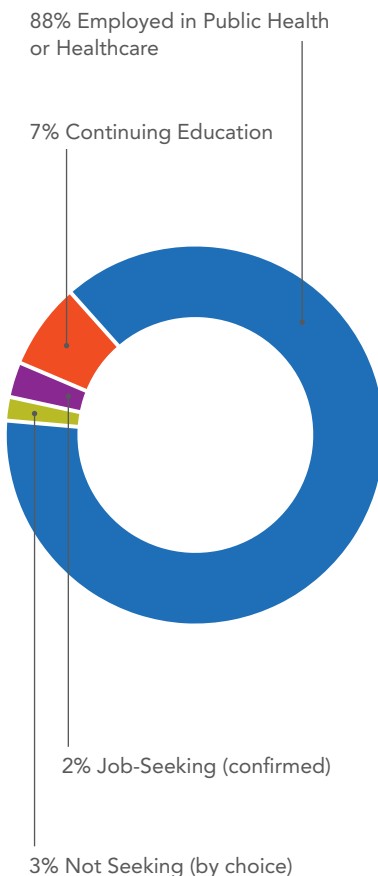
High-Quality Services for Employers
