Howard Nadel graduated from the Columbia College of Pharmaceutical Sciences in 1974. Following graduation, he served the University in many official capacities, and was awarded Columbia's Alumni Federation Medal in 1989. Howard worked with several retail pharmacies before joining the pharmacy at Jacobi Medical Center in the Bronx in 1981. Throughout his career at Jacobi, he has held many positions including Purchasing Pharmacist and Director of Operations of Inpatient Pharmacy Services. In 1998, he was awarded the coveted Smithsonian Medal for 21st Century Innovation Technology that benefits the public's health and welfare.



In 2000, he left the pharmacy to develop a Research Center for the North Bronx Healthcare Network, exploring drugs and devices in virtually every therapeutic area. Additionally, since 2005, Howard has served as the Administrative Director of the Jacobi Medical Center Human Genetics Laboratory.
