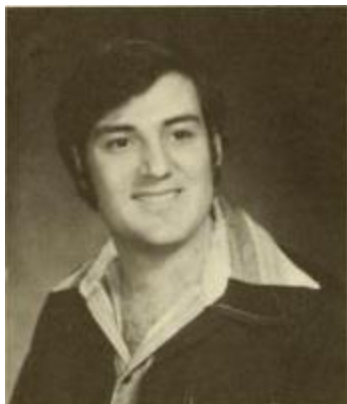


### Alumni Board Member Jay Messeroff BS '76
