


Jeff Voigt, MPH '83

Jeff is the principal of Medical Device Consultants of Ridgewood, a firm dedicated to ensuring appropriate coverage and payment policies for medical technology companies (mainly early stage or; at market introduction) and insurers. His expertise also includes healthcare analytics, cost-effectiveness analysis, evidence development, and assessment. These are in turn are used to assist policy makers in developing coverage for technologies that provide value. Jeff has published over 20 peer reviewed articles on evidence assessments, cost-effectiveness, and health policy commentary in some of the leading medical specialty and policy journals.



Jeff's education includes: a bachelor's degree from University Vermont, a Master of Public Health from Columbia University, and a Master of Business Administration from the Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania. Jeff recently served as President of the Wharton Healthcare Management Alumni Association (WHCMAA) and was on the WHCMAA board from 2010-2015. As President, Jeff led the alumni board and the alumni in significantly increasing annual scholarship giving and; in improving educational content and interaction amongst alumni while; quadrupling the WHCMAA's budget in a "profitable" way. These profits in turn were funneled back into scholarship giving to the Wharton Health Care Program. He also currently serves on the Columbia SPH alumni board and as well on the Executive Board of the Leonard Davis Institute (LDI), University of Pennsylvania. LDI is one of the leading think tanks for health care policy in the US. Jeff is also actively involved in his community of Ridgewood, NJ as a member of the zoning board, with his church, with the Knights of Columbus, and as a newly elected Village of Ridgewood Council member.
